**Because Jesus is King, we learn to live the way of Jesus.**

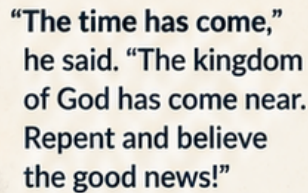

The King has come near.

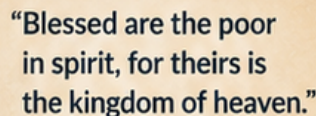
